MEMBERSHIP DRIVE

- There were total 42 membership application, 20 for PLM, 10 for associate members and 6 PLM to LM and 6 applied for life membership. And 2 LM are pending due to payment.

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

A) Leprosy day -This year IADVL Maharashtra branch marked the LEPROSY day by conducting 2 CME programmes, one at Navi Mumbai and second at Nanded. Patient awareness program was conducted at BJ Medical college at Pune. Few medical check up camps were also organised In Navi Mumbai, Kalyan and Haranbori.

In mumbai, under the leadership of Dr. Sharmila patil , Dr. DY Patil medical college organised CME on leprosy. Experts in the field like Dr. Waman Bhakti who is ex- chief medical superintendent of peripheral hospital in Mumbai Municipal corporation spoke on chemotherapy of leprosy. Dr. Vivek Pai director of Bombay Leprosy project explained difference between relapse and reaction. Dr. Manjunath Shenoy, Dr. Nitin Nadkarni & Dr. Mahendra Kura enlightened us by actively participating in the panel discussion.80 delegates attended the CME.

Nanded also hosted a CME on leprosy which was organised by Dr. P.D. Joshi Patodikar and Dr. Vinod Chavan in collaboration with Hind-kushth samitee. The programme was a success and was attended by 175 delegates.

B) Quarterly scientific meet - On 10th March 2019, 1st quarterly scientific meet was held at Hotel Orchid in Mumbai, on the following theme “ Immunology and skin - from basics to biologicals”. It started with understanding the newer concepts in immunobullous disorder and lepra reaction. Immunodiagnostics in drug reaction was well explained by Dr. Rajesh Kumar. Dr. Nidhi Sharma explained allergy testing and Dr. Balkrishnan covered diagnosis and management in Connective tissue disorder. Dr. Smita Prabhu from Manipal gave us a realistic view on immunomodulators. Dr. Sujal Suneetha enlightened on vaccines in leprosy and Dr. Sharmila Patil spoke on immunotherapy in genital and

common warts. Dr. Vishalakshmi, Dr. Tahiliani , Dr. Pai and Dr. Sharmila enlightened the audience on biologicals. This was attended by more than 200 delegates.

C) Clinical meeting - On 1st March 2019, clinical meet was organised by KEM Hospital where multiple long and short cases were discussed such as interstitial granulomas, genodermatoses, hidden side of mycoses, multiple myeloma and lentiginous melanoma.

D) Conferences organised in association with IADVL - On 15-17 February 2019, MEDINSPIRE a multi-disciplinary conference which was organised by Dr. DY Patil medical college, under the leadership of Dr. Sharmila Patil , IADVL state secretary and Dr. Kiran Godse, President IADVL . Workshop which included live demonstration of nail surgery, vitiligo grafting , botox, filler, PRP. Conference concentrated on allergy wherein international speaker Dr. Zuberbier and Dr. Wollenburg with national speakers spoke very well. Second day had talks on systemic involvement and skin, and advances in leprosy and update on STD.

On 16-17 th January, Dermascopy workshop cum conference was conducted by Dr. Subrata Malakar (Rita Skin Foundation) along with IADVL Maharashtra branch. Dr. Antonella Tosti, Dr. Gabriella Fabbrocini, Dr. Lidia Rudnicka & Dr. Bruna Estrada were the international faculty along with multiple national faculty gave lecturers.
