

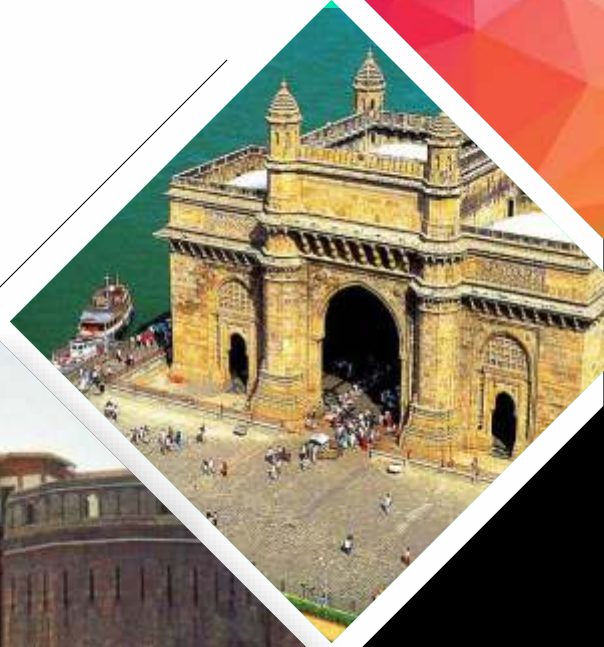

- **AWARDS :**

Dr. A. C. Parikh award is given to postgraduate residents for Best Paper Presentation. One paper (Case reports/case series) will be nominated by each Head of Department (HOD) from Medical Colleges in Maharashtra.

Kindly Submit Letter of recommendation from the HOD for this award along with the abstract.

Dr. S. L. Wadhwa Award is awarded to postgraduate residents for Best Research Paper. One research study to be nominated by each Head of Department from Medical Colleges in Maharashtra. These can include clinical trials, epidemiological and investigational studies. However, multicentric pharma sponsored studies should be avoided.

DR. D. J. PATIL AWARD :

This session shall comprise papers on most interesting case from life members of IADVL Maharashtra. This award is not open to residents.

Criteria for most interesting case: 1. Complicated presentation of common disorder 2. Rare presentation of a common disorder 3. A case having diagnostic clue 4. Reported but uncommon finding 4. New and unusual treatment modality 5. Unusual complication of therapy 6. Unforeseen complication 7. Unforgettable incidence in treating a case

Minimum 3, maximum 5 papers will be selected from the entries received for presentation.

The best presentation will be given the DR D.J. Patil award
